Akira Takada is anthropologist and associate professor at Graduate School of Asian and African Area Studies (ASAFAAS) in Kyoto University. He is a specialist on childhood in hunter-gatherer societies, and he has mainly worked on the following four areas of study among several groups of the San (a.k.a. Bushmen) in Southern Africa: caregiver-child interaction; the system of caregiver-child interaction, subsistence activity, and the natural environment; environmental perception; the transformation of ethnicity.
